<b>Adjective - ( Noun + ed )</b>	a <b>dark-haired</b> man a <b>green-eyed</b> girl a <b>light-hearted</b> banter a <b>middle-aged</b> lady
<b>Adjective - ( Verb+ing ) / Gerund</b>	a <b>nice-looking</b> girl a <b>long-lasting</b> affair
<b>Adverb - ( Verb + ing )</b>	a <b>fast-running</b> man
<b>Noun - ( Verb + ing )</b>	a <b>water-conducting</b> pipe
<b>Noun - Adjective</b>	an <b>ice-cold</b> drink an <b>olive-green</b> shirt
<b>Adjective - Noun</b>	a <b>round-table</b> discussion a <b>red-light</b> district
<b>Adverb - Past Participle</b>	a <b>well-known</b> scientist. a <b>highly-equipped</b> school
<b>Verb - Adjective</b> <b>Verb - Adverb</b>	a <b>feel-good</b> factor a <b>pay-later</b> purchase
<b>Number OR Numeral - singular noun</b>	<b>seven-year</b> itch / <b>five-sided</b> polygon <b>20th-century</b> poem / <b>30-piece</b> band a <b>ten-pound</b> note a <b>second-hand</b> furniture
<b>Number - year - old</b>	a <b>ten-year-old</b> boy a <b>fifty-year-old</b> lady
<b>Verb - preposition</b>	<b>stick-on</b> label / <b>walk-on</b> part
<b>Colours in compounds</b>	a <b>dark-blue</b> sweater / a <b>reddish-orange</b> dress
<b>Comparatives and superlatives in compound</b>	the <b>highest-placed</b> competitor a <b>shorter-term</b> loan
<b>Compounds including two geographical modifiers</b>	<b>Afro-Cuban</b> <b>African-American</b> / <b>Anglo-Asian</b>
